As we look forward to plans for the ships this year. The Schooner Lettie G. Howard is required by the USCG to be hauled out and inspected this year. The shipyard where the ships will go to be hauled out is in Cleveland.

We are making plans to send Lettie to the shipyard in April. Before transit to Cleveland we will need to hire a seasonal captain and crew to prepare the ship and bring it to ship yard.
